We ask you to please korero with your children about road safety and where the safe places are to cross.

### 3 TIPS TO KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE.

- Use the school pedestrian crossing even when you are with an adult.
- All children with a scooter or bike must wear a helmet to and from school. No helmet = no bike or scooter.
- Always look both ways before you cross the road – even at a pedestrian crossing.

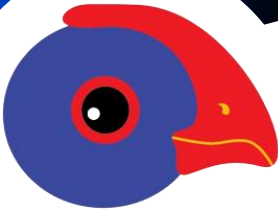


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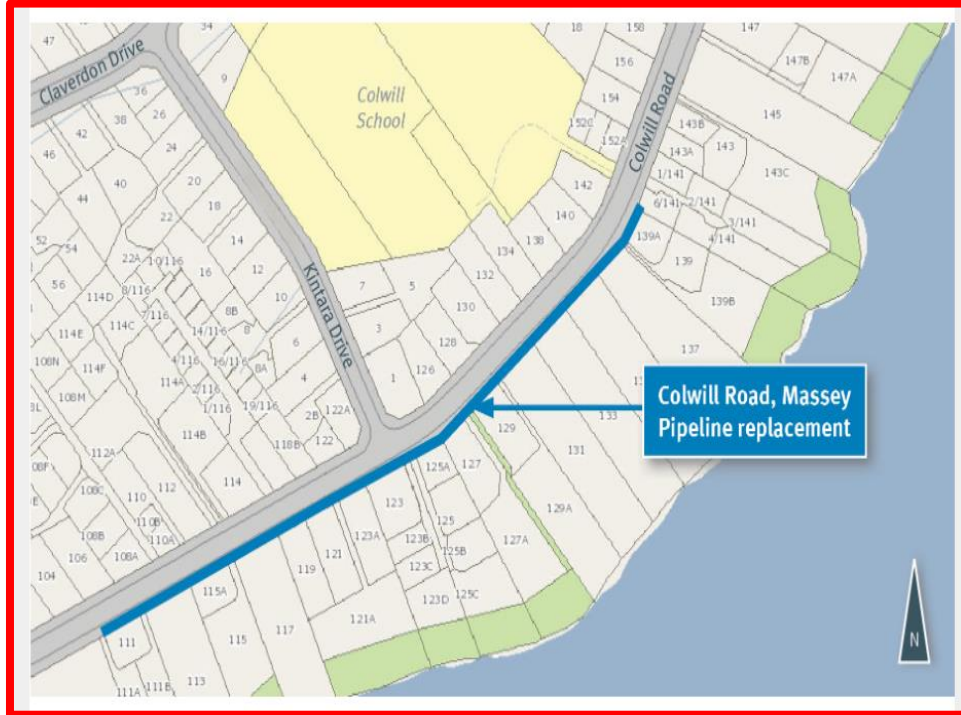

On Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024, our contractors will be undertaking work to upgrade a short section of the water main along Colwill Road in Massey – see the map below. These works are a part of Watercare's programme to upgrade aging watermains that are susceptible to breaks ensuring the security of your water supply in Massey.



### How will these works affect you?

- The work is expected to take place over approximately 7 weeks.
- Work hours will typically be from 9:00am to 3:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:30am to 6:00pm on Saturday and School holidays. Please note that these hours were selected to help reduce the impact on students and parents of Colwill School as much as practical.
- While the work may generate some noise, please be assured that it will be kept to a minimum and within levels approved by Auckland Council. .
- Toward the end of the project, we will need to undertake a water shutdown. We will notify affected parties five days in advance of the shutdown, and it will be planned at a time that will minimise disruption.
- The water meter serving your property may be replaced/relocated during these renewal works. If we need to access your property you will be notified in advance.
- You may also notice the following temporary changes along Colwill Road and surrounding streets in Massey:
  - Reduced on-street parking
  - Reduced lane widths
  - Reduced speed limits
  - Pedestrian detours/reduced footpath width
- Bus stop relocations on Colwill Road - Bus Stop 5592 will temporarily close, please use bus Stop 5590. Please refer to the Auckland Transport website or app and plan ahead.

We thank you in advance for your patience and we will ensure measures are in place to minimise any unnecessary disruption for the duration of this project.
